

What is an Integrated Care System?



We think that all the organisations involved in health and care in Norfolk and Waveney should work together. This is called an **integrated care system** or **ICS** for short



We already **work** like this in Norfolk and Waveney but now it will happen everywhere in England



Integrated care systems are about **planning** health and care services based on **what people need** in their area

They will work with local people to decide what to do





Norfolk and Waveney's integrated care system will:

- make sure that people can live as healthy a life as possible
- make sure that you only have to tell your story once
- make Norfolk and Waveney the best place to work in health and care

As part of Norfolk and Waveney's **integrated care system**, NHS England have told us some ways in which we should be working with people and communities

The main areas of work below, are what people have told us are important:




 We will listen to what you have already told us and other health and care organisations in Norfolk and Waveney
